



Firebird Grill

| <p>Included are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Firebird grill• Grill rack• Charcoal tray• Bowed back bar for locking charcoal tray• 3 anchor brackets for locking base• 3 locking stakes | <p>To install:</p> <p>Place the grill in the desired position. May be secured into the ground with the 3 anchor brackets and stakes. Attach the anchor brackets first and then place the stakes through the holes in the bracket.</p> <p>Insert the charcoal tray in either the high position for cooking or the lower position and lock with the bowed back bar. Add the grill rack and place on any of the 4 cooking levels. Ready to barbeque and grill!</p> |

| <p>Tips for use:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use as a grill and enjoy cooking with charcoal wood briquettes for a natural tasting outdoor barbeque flavor• At night the grill transforms into a campfire with wood logs on the grill pan• A winter gathering place for hot cider and sausages outside |
| <p>Corten Steel – a.k.a. weathering steel, a special alloy that uses copper and nickel to create a weather-resistant surface. Can be left untreated and is maintenance free.</p> <p>Stainless Steel – the grill rack, back bar, and stakes are made of heavy stainless steel. Clean with detergent and water as needed.</p> |
