The six versions include: Cubic 215 – 7' high; Cubic 166 – 51/2' high; Cubic 109 – 31/2' high; Cubic Corner; Cubic Wall; and Cubic W200 – 61/2' long with side wood holder. This "fire tower in a box" offers storage, warmth and great design all in the same neat package.

Along with its fashionable looks, design features such as the concealed door handle, has finger-tip control for easy opening and closing. The burning system designed with high fuel efficiency provides higher combustion temperatures and lower atmospheric emissions.
