## How to Clean Stove Glass - 101



Owning a wood burning stove is a good investment that will keep on giving. It is important to clean the glass periodically to keep it free of creosote build-up; here's how!

- 1. Use a moist paper towel and dip it into some of the fine ash inside your firebox.
- 2. Rub the glass with the paper towel in a circular motion until the entire surface is covered.
- 3. To remove the ash-paste, reverse the process using a clean moist paper towel.
- 4. For tough stains make a thick paste from the ash and leave it on for 10-15 minutes, then remove.
